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SUSAN: *female adult*

PRINCESS JAZZ-BELLA ARIELLA SNOWRELLA: *female adult or teen*

Scene:

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Children's Church, the present

Costumes:

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SUSAN: *casual clothing*

ROBBY THE ROBOT: *Robot costume*

PRINCESS JAZZ-BELLA ARIELLA SNOWRELLA: *princess costume*

Props:

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Large book (Rhyming Bible)

Running time:

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5 minutes

Notes:

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*This short sketch teaches about Jesus' miracles and power over death. Topics: Luke 8, The daughter of Jairus, The woman with the issue of blood, Miracles*

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*(Robby and Susan enter from opposite sides)*

ROBBY: **Greetings!**

SUSAN: **Hey, it's Robby the Robot! How are you doing?**

ROBBY: **I am quite satisfactory.**

SUSAN: **I was just about to tell the kids a Bible story.**

ROBBY: **I have already downloaded the entire Bible, but I would still like to hear it. I find human behavior fascinating.**

SUSAN: **Okay, well today's story is...**

*Princess enters with large storybook*

PRINCESS: *(with a high-pitched princess voice)* **Why, hello there! Are you the princess of this castle?**

SUSAN: **Um, no, I'm not a princess. I'm a teacher here in Children's Ministries.**

PRINCESS: **Oh, my! What a strange castle this is. *(to Robby)* Oh, look, a tin man. You're an awfully long way from the yellow brick road, aren't you?**

ROBBY: **I am a titanium carbonic alloy. I am not tin.**

SUSAN: **Who are you?**

PRINCESS: **How very silly of me. My name is Princess Jazz-Bella Ariella Snowrella.**

SUSAN: **I'm Susan, this is Robby. Nice to meet you, but what are you doing here?**

PRINCESS: **I must have taken a wrong turn in the enchanted forest. *(sees kids in audience)* Oh my! Look at all these little dwarves! Do you take care of them all? I've never seen so many!**

SUSAN: **These are children, not dwarves.**

PRINCESS: **Why, then you must be the woman who lives in the shoe... she had so many children, she didn't know what to do....**

SUSAN: **No, princess. I don't live in a shoe. Look, I've got a Bible story to teach to these kids. Do ya' mind? *(motions for her to leave the stage)***

PRINCESS: **Oh! I love stories! Can I tell the story?**

SUSAN: **Do you know the story of Jairus and his sick daughter?**
